Zuni is a pleasure to work with. Even being only three, she is very willing, sweet and polite. She loves to spend times with people and never has a bad attitude about coming out to work. She definitely responds best to someone who is quiet and gentle, as she is very sensitive. Zuni is very calm, with slow, controlled gaits. She is not pushy on the bit or your leg. As of now she will take both leads, hold a circle nicely on a loose rein, side-pass, go out on trail and yield very well off your leg. She is also beginning to learn collection and more skilled pivots. She is easy to ride both bare back and in a halter as she is very reliable and responsive. She does not have issues with separating from other horses, and though she can get a little excited, she loves being out on trail and playing in water.

Someone looking to adopt Zuni should be a smaller person (she is a very little, fine bones horse), with light hands who rides well with his/her body. Zuni needs a lot of attention, love and a gentle rider. She is very fond of being groomed and loved on. She has a very playful (but respectful) personality and someone looking at adopting her needs to be willing to provide her with mental stimulation (toys, attention and enough space). Most importantly though, she should be adopted by a smaller person with light hands who is willing to fall in love with her quirky personality.
